H 223. NO HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PROJ. REQUIRED. Filed 2/18/09. REMOVING THE HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PROJECT AS A REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATION AND DIRECTING THE PROGRAM EVALUATION DIVISION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO STUDY THE COST OF THE EFFECTIVENESS OF REQUIRING A HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PROJECT.

Amends GS 115C-81(b) to direct the State Board of Education not to include a high school graduation project as a requirement for receiving a high school diploma for any student; however, provides that local boards of education may choose to require their students to complete a high school graduation project.

Directs the Program Evaluation Division of the General Assembly to study the cost and effectiveness of requiring a statewide high school graduation project and to report the study results to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by July 1, 2010.
