H 256. UNC/CALCULATION OF IN-STATE STUDENTS. Filed 2/19/09. *TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND ITS CONSTITUTENT INSTITUTIONS SHALL NOT COUNT OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS AS IN-STATE STUDENTS FOR ANY CALCULATION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM'S STUDENT POPULATION.*

Enacts GS 116-43.16 prohibiting UNC and its constituent institutions from counting any out of state student as an in-state student for any calculations related to the University System student population. Applies beginning with the 2009-10 academic year.

H 256. UNC/CALCULATION OF IN-STATE STUDENTS. Filed 2/19/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes proposed new GS 116-43.16, which prohibited counting any out-of-state student as an in-state student for any calculation regarding the UNC system student population. Instead, amends GS 116-143.6 to authorize that, by resolution, a board of trustees of a UNC constituent institution may consider all undergraduate persons receiving full scholarships from entities recognized by the institution as state residents for *tuition purposes only*. Requires that those individuals be counted as out-of-state students for any policy adopted by the UNC Board of Governors that limits out-of-state-undergraduate enrollment.

Changes the effective date to when the act becomes law (was, effective for the 2009-10 academic year and each subsequent academic year).
