H 263. FUNDS/NCSU VET. TEACHING & RESEARCH FUND. Filed 2/23/09. TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COLLEGE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE CLINICAL TEACHING AND RESEARCH FUND.

Appropriates \$250,000 for 2009-10 from the General Fund to the UNC Board of Governors to be allocated to NC State University for the College of Veterinary Medicine Clinical Teaching and Research Fund. The funds are to be used to (1) allow advanced diagnostic and treatment options for animals of all species presented to the college's teaching hospital and services where either the owner has limited financing options, significant instructional value exists, or the conduct of such diagnostic treatment options has the potential to add significantly to core knowledge in the relevant clinical area and (2) allow establishment and support of a Veterinary Clinical Trials Program aimed at generating new, clinically relevant knowledge across multiple species by assessment of the efficacy of novel diagnostics, therapeutics, and treatment modalities in a broad population of relevant species. Effective July 1, 2009.
