Changes the title to *A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE NAACP'S CENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY*. Amends and adds to the whereas clauses. Provides that the General Assembly honors the memory of those who founded the NAACP for their vision and the service they rendered *our nation and state*. Requires the Secretary of State to transmit a certified copy of the resolution to the President of the North Carolina Conference of NAACP Branches (was, to Rev. Dr. William J. Barber II).
