H 381. EXPAND DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MGMT. AUTHORITY. Filed 3/4/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Declares the Division of Emergency Management in the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety to be the lead state agency for "coordinating information and resources" for hazard risk management, rather than the lead for hazard risk management itself. Deletes reference to other state and county governments as "supporting" governments. Explicitly affirms that when other state agencies have primary responsibility for the adoption of hazard mitigation standards, those standards will be applied in hazard risk analyses. Directs the Division of Emergency Management to maintain a clearinghouse for hazard estimation methodologies and metrics, rather than directing that Division *establish* those methodologies and metrics.
