H 44. THREE-FIFTHS VOTE TO LEVY TAXES. Filed 2/3/09. TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF NORTH CAROLINA TO REQUIRE A THREE-FIFTHS VOTE FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO LEVY TAXES.

Subject to approval by the voters at the November 2010 general election, amends Section 23 of Article II of the North Carolina Constitution, to require a three-fifths vote by the Senate and a three-fifths vote by the House of Representatives in order to enact a law that imposes any tax upon the people of North Carolina. Applies to laws increasing a tax rate and laws levying a new tax. Does not apply to laws repealing or restricting a specific tax preference or authorizing local taxing units to levy a tax. Effective upon certification of the amendment by the State Board of Elections. Makes technical changes.
