H 492. OCCUPATIONAL EXT. COURSES EARN BUDGET FTE. Filed 3/5/09. *TO AUTHORIZE COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO EARN BUDGET FTE FOR CERTAIN OCCUPATIONAL EXTENSION COURSES.*

Enacts new GS 115D-5.1(f4) (related to workforce development programs) to provide that, when a college pays 50% or more of the instructional costs for occupational extension courses taught as part of an approved customized training project, membership hours in the courses are to be counted when computing full-time equivalent students (FTE) for use in budget funding formulas at the state level. Requires that colleges waive student registration fees for these courses and may use customized training funds for the remainder of the costs of the courses. Effective July 1, 2009.
