H 633. YANCEY COMMISSIONERS ELECTION. Filed 3/17/09. RELATING TO THE MANNER OF ELECTION AND ORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF YANCEY COUNTY.

Effective on the first Monday in December 2010, expands the Yancey County Board of Commissioners from three to five members and requires the selection of the chairman to be in accordance with GS 153A-39. In 2010, five members are to be elected with the two individuals receiving the highest number of votes elected to four-year terms and the three individuals receiving the next highest number of votes elected to two-year terms. In 2012 and biennially thereafter, three members are to be elected with the two individuals receiving the highest number of votes elected to four year terms and the individual receiving the next highest number of votes elected to a two-year term. Beginning with the 2010 election, abolishes the office of chairman as a separately elective office.

Repeals Chapter 127, Public-Local Acts of 1923 (defining the duties of the Yancey County Board of Commissioners and fixing their compensation).
