Modifies proposed amended GS 75-102(m) to provide that the Attorney General, in consultation with the Public Staff of the Public Utilities Commission, must draft the contents of a bill insert or bill message, a direct mailing, and an e-mail (was, draft a bill insert, bill message, or direct mail, including e-mail when affirmatively selected by the customer) that notifies consumers of the existence of the "Do Not Call" Registry and includes specific related information. Also makes technical and clarifying changes.
