H 747. ASHEVILLE FORCE ACCOUNT. Filed 3/23/09. *INCREASING THE FORCE ACCOUNT LIMIT FOR THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE AND BUNCOMBE COUNTY FOR CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR PROJECTS.*

Amends GS 143-135 for construction and repair work contracts excluded from public contracts requirements to raise the limit to \$250,000 for the total cost of the project (was, \$125,000 for the total cost of the project, or \$50,000 for the labor costs) for Marjorie Street, Valley Street, College Street, and Davidson Street projects in the areas of the Buncombe County jail annex, the City of Asheville, and Buncombe County. Expires July 1, 2010.

H 747. ASHEVILLE AND DALLAS FORCE ACCOUNT (NEW). Filed 3/23/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 143-135 to provide that Article 8 of GS Chapter 143 (Public contracts) does not apply to state or local government construction and repair work contracts when the work is performed under certain circumstances and the total cost of the project does not exceed \$500,000 (was, \$125,000 for the total cost of the project or \$50,000 for the total labor costs). Applies only to police department renovations in the Town of Dallas. Expires July 1, 2011.

Makes conforming changes to the title.

Amends GS 143-135 to provide that, as applied to police department renovations in the Town of Dallas, Article 8 of GS Chapter 143 (Public contracts) does not apply to state or local government construction and repair work contracts when the work is performed under certain circumstances and the total cost of the project does not exceed \$250,000 (was, \$500,000 in the 2nd edition).
