H 767. CRAVEN ROAD HUNTING. Filed 3/24/09. TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM OR ACROSS THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF A PORTION OF STATE ROAD 1862, KNOWN AS JOYNER DRIVE, IN CRAVEN COUNTY.

Makes it a Class 3 misdemeanor for a person to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird with firearms from, on, or across the right-of-way of State Secondary Road 1862, known as Joyner Drive, from Adams Creek Road to the end of the state-maintained portion of the road, unless that person owns or possesses a leasehold interest in the real property immediately adjacent to the portion of the road on which the person is located. Provides that the act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. Applies to Craven County only. Effective October 1, 2009.
