H 847. LEGISLATIVE COMMISSION ON GASOLINE SHORTAGES. Filed 3/26/09. TO ESTABLISH THE LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON GASOLINE SHORTAGES.

Establishes 15-member commission charged with studying the issue of gasoline shortages experienced in the state following hurricanes in 2008 and identifying methods of avoiding shortages in the future. Requires appointment of five members by each chamber and five members by the Governor. Requires a final report to the General Assembly by the 2010 Regular Session with termination upon filing the report or the convening of the 2011 General Assembly, whichever is earlier. Appropriates \$50,000 in 2009-10 and \$50,000 in 2010-11 from the General Fund to the General Assembly to support the study.
