Changes title to AN ACT TO INCLUDE CITIES AND COUNTIES IN TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR MAPPING. TO CONFORM STATUES TO COUNTY AUTHORITY AUTHORIZED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND TO ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO FURNISH ROAD MAINTENANCE MATERIALS TO MUNICIPALITIES ON A COST REIMBURSEMENT BASIS. Proposes new GS 136-34.1 authorizing the Department of Transportation to furnish municipalities road maintenance

materials upon agreement for reimbursement. Reimbursement would be in an amount at least equal to the cost of materials, plus the actual reasonable cost of handling and storing the materials and of administering the agreement. Provides for certain limitations. Deletes amendments to GS 136-66.1(1), GS 136-66.2 and GS 136-41.1(a), respectively.

Changes the act's effective date to August 1, 2009 (was, July 1, 2009). Amends the title.
