H 899. LIMIT FOODS IN SCHOOL VENDING MACHINES. Filed 3/30/09. TO ENSURE THAT SCHOOL VENDING MACHINES CONTAIN ONLY FOODS AND BEVERAGES PERMITTED BY LAW.

Amends GS 115C-264.2 (setting standards for the sale of beverages and snacks in vending machines at schools during the school day) to direct the principal of a school that has vending machines to enter into a memoranda of agreement with the beverage and snack vendors to ensure that the contents of the vending machines meet or exceed the standards set out in GS 115C-264.2. Requires the principal to submit a copy of the agreement to the Department of Public Instruction prior to January 1 of each year. Applies beginning with the 2009-10 school year.
