H 952. STUDY MERIT-BASED COMPONENTS/TEACHER SALARY. Filed 3/31/09. *TO ESTABLISH THE LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMITTEE ON TEACHER COMPENSATION.*

Creates a Legislative Study Committee on Teacher Compensation (Committee), consisting of members from the General Assembly, the North Carolina Association of Educators, Inc., the School Boards Association, the Public School Forum, and the Association of School Administrators. The Committee is ordered to study the state's teacher compensation system and to consider whether the system should include merit-based components. Requires the Committee to report its results to the 2010 Regular Session. Effective July 1, 2009.

H 952. STUDY MERIT-BASED COMPONENTS/ TEACHER SALARY. Filed 3/31/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition.

Provides that a majority of the members of the Legislative Study Committee on Teacher Compensation (Committee) constitutes a quorum. Provides that the Committee members are to receive per diem, subsistence, and travel allowances in accordance with GS 120-3.1, GS 138-5, or GS 138-6. Adds a termination date for the Committee, providing that it is to terminate on May 1, 2010, or upon the filing of its final report, whichever comes first. Modifies the membership requirements of the Committee to provide that of the five members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and of the five members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, two out of the five members appointed from the respective bodies must be from the minority party in that body. Makes technical changes.
