H 970. GRANVILLE COUNTY HUNTING. Filed 4/1/09. *TO REGULATE HUNTING IN GRANVILLE COUNTY.*

Makes it a Class 2 misdemeanor for a person to release a dog or dogs onto property (1) that is owned by another for the purpose of hunting deer, or (2) with the actual or constructive knowledge that the dog or dogs are likely to go on the landowner's land in pursuit of deer, (3) without the landowner's written consent, and (4) providing that the property is posted or registered and posted as provided under various provisions of state law. Makes this act enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. Applies only to Granville County. Becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to acts committed on or after that date.
