S 1010. MIGRATORY GAME BIRD SEASON AUTHORITY. Filed 3/25/09. TO AUTHORIZE THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION TO ADOPT SEASON STRUCTURES FOR MIGRATORY GAME BIRD SEASONS AND TO ALLOW THE USE OF UNPLUGGED SHOTGUNS AND ELECTRONIC CALLS.

Amends GS 113-291.2 to authorize the Wildlife Resources Commission to issue proclamations to set seasons and other hunting guidelines for wild animals and birds that are consistent with the federal season framework and guidelines. Also adds new subsection GS 113-291.1(f1) authorizing the Commission to issue proclamations allowing the use of electronic calls or unplugged shotguns. Allows the Commission to delegate this proclamation authority to the Executive Director. Requires the Director to make reasonable efforts to notify affected persons of proclamations. Provides that proclamations remain in force until rescinded. Makes conforming change to GS 113-291.1(f) and GS 113-291.2.

S 1010. MIGRATORY GAME BIRD SEASON AUTHORITY. Filed 3/25/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Specifically references, in proposed amended GS 113-291.2(a) (related to shooting hours, seasons, possession limits, and bag limits on migratory game birds) and GS 113-291.1(f) (related to conforming state law with federal law regarding migratory game birds), new provisions to be added to those statutes that direct the Wildlife Resources Commission to issue certain proclamations related to migratory game birds to achieve conformity with applicable federal law. Makes conforming changes by restoring language in existing statutory provisions. Also makes an organizational change to proposed amended GS 113-291.2.
