S 106. MORATORIUM ON EMC RULE MAKING (NEW). Filed 2/10/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Deletes entire contents of the previous edition and replaces it with *AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT COMMISSION FROM ADOPTING PERMANENT RULES FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT UNTIL JULY 1, 2011, EXCEPT UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.* Prohibits the Environmental Management Commission (Commission) from adopting any permanent rule for the period beginning the day this act becomes law and ending July 1, 2011. Provides that the Commission may adopt a permanent rule during the moratorium period if the adoption of the rule is required by one or more of the following: (1) a serious or unforeseen threat to public health, safety, welfare, the environment, or natural resources; (2) an act of the General Assembly or US Congress specifically directing the Commission to adopt a rule; (3) a change in federal or state budgetary policy; (4) a federal regulation; or (5) a court order.
