S 1072. ITS COLLABORATION WITH AGENCIES (NEW). Filed 3/26/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Changes title to *AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW TO ENSURE COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES AND STATE AGENCIES REGARDING THE CONSOLIDATION OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY RESOURCE CENTERS AND SERVICES.* Deletes provision exempting the Department of the Secretary of State from the authority of the Office of Information Technology. Adds language amending GS 147-33.83(a)(1) to require the Office of Information Technology to collaborate with executive departments and state agencies before consolidating information resource centers and services. Collaboration includes entering into a written agreement with the department, identifying department-specific applications and staffing requirements, maintaining quality and security, identifying costs associated with consolidation, and agreeing on an implementation timeline. Disagreements must be settled using the Agency/State CIO dispute resolution process established in GS 147-33.72D.
