**S 1082. JUVENILE RECORDS/PROBATION RISK ASSESSMENT.** Filed 3/26/09. *ALLOWING PROBATION OFFICERS IN THE DIVISION OF COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ACCESS TO THE JUVENILE RECORDS OF PERSONS SUBJECT TO PROBATION UNDER THEIR SUPERVISION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING RISK ASSESSMENT FOR PROBATION.*

Current law provides that juvenile records may be examined only by order of the court, with a specified list of exceptions identifying persons who may examine the juvenile's record and obtain written copies of parts of the record without a court order. Amends GS 7B-3000 to add probation officers in the Division of Community Corrections of the Department of Corrections to those persons meeting the exception thereby permitting them to access juvenile records without a court order. Provides that during any time that a person is under probation supervision under GS Chapter 15A, Article 82, that person's juvenile record may be examined without a court order by the probation officer assigned to that person for the purpose of determining risk assessment. Makes conforming changes to GS 7B-3100(a) and GS 15A-1341. Effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.

Amends proposed GS 7B-3000(e1) to allow a probation officer in the Division of Community Corrections assigned to supervise a person subject to probation under Article 82 of GS Chapter 15A to examine the person's juvenile record without a court order at any time during which the person is subject to probation for the purpose of assessing risk related to supervision (was, for the purpose of determining risk assessment). Makes a conforming change to the title.
