S 1088. FUNERAL EXPENSES STATE HIGHWAY PATROL. Filed 3/26/09. *TO MAKE PERMANENT A LAW ALLOWING THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY TO EXPEND FUNDS TO COVER FUNERAL EXPENSES FOR MEMBERS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.*

Amends Section 3 of SL 2008-142 to delete the June 1, 2009 sunset date for GS 143B-476(i). That provision allows the Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety to use up to \$10,000 from the funds available to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety as reimbursement for funeral expenses to the family of a member of the State Highway Patrol who is killed in the line of duty, provided that funding is available.
