S 126. AMEND DRINKING WATER TESTING/PRIVATE WELLS. Filed 2/11/09. TO AMEND THE TESTING REQUIREMENTS FOR NEWLY CONSTRUCTED PRIVATE DRINKING WATER WELLS FOLLOWING ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION.

Amends GS 87-97(h) (effective October 1, 2009) to limit the testing of well water for methyl tert-butyl ether, ethylene dibromide, 1,2-dichloroethane, 1,2-dichloropropane, isopropyl ether, benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylenes, trichloroethylene, and tetrachloroethylene to newly constructed wells located within 1,500 feet of a site that produced one or more of the compounds specified in the additional testing parameters, as determined by the local health department (was, for all newly constructed wells following the issuance of a certification of completion).
