S 1345. GREENSBORO/RELOCATION OF WILDLIFE. Filed 5/25/10. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to the 1st edition. Establishes a program in Greensboro allowing beavers taken along Buffalo Creek to be relocated to an alternative habitat along Buffalo Creek, (was, allowed beavers *and* wild animals of the order Carnivora to be relocated to an alternative habitat, without the taking and relocation limitation to Buffalo Creek) with the consent of the new habitat's landowner. Applies only to depredation permits issued to Greensboro. Adds that the provision expires July 1, 2011. Makes conforming changes to the title.
