S 1358. SCHOOL CALENDAR FLEXIBILITY/INCLEMENT WEATHER. Filed 5/24/10. TO GIVE FLEXIBILITY TO MAKE UP INSTRUCTIONAL DAYS MISSED DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER DURING THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR TO LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS LOCATED IN CHEROKEE, CLAY, GRAHAM, HAYWOOD, JACKSON, MACON, SWAIN, AND TRANSYLVANIA COUNTIES.

Amends GS 115C-84.2(a)(1) to allow a local board of education to comply with the school calendar requirement by scheduling 1,000 hours of instruction on less than 180 days on account of inclement weather. Provides that, as a result, the local school administrative unit meets the minimum 180-day requirement for instruction days, teachers, and employees. Makes conforming changes. Applies to Cherokee, Clay, Graham, Haywood, Jackson, Macon, Swain, and Transylvania counties for the 2009-10 school year only.
