**S 137. MILITARY DEATH/IN-STATE TUITION/DEPENDENT.** Filed 2/11/09. *TO PROVIDE THAT A DEPENDENT RELATIVE OF A MEMBER OF THE ARMED SERVICES CONTINUES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR IN-STATE TUITION IF THE ACTIVE DUTY MEMBER IS KILLED IN COMBAT OR DIES DURING ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY WHILE ASSIGNED TO NORTH CAROLINA.*

Amends GS 116-143.3(c) to provide that after a member of the armed services is killed in combat, noncombat deployment, or dies during active military duty, a dependent relative will continue to be eligible for the in-state tuition rate and applicable mandatory fees, provided that the member was assigned to North Carolina at the time of death. Effective October 1, 2009.

**S 137. MILITARY DEATH/IN-STATE TUITION/DEPENDENT.** Filed 2/11/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 116-143.3(c) to limit the period for which the in-state tuition rate eligibility continues for a dependent relative to 10 years after the armed service member's death.

**S 137. MILITARY DEATH/IN-STATE TUITION/DEPENDENT.** Filed 2/11/09. Senate amendment makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Provides in proposed amended GS 116-143.3(c) that if the dependent relative of a member of the armed services who is killed in combat or noncombat deployment or dies during active military duty enrolls in a degree or other program within 10 years after the death of the member and the course of study extends beyond that 10-year period, the dependent relative continues to be eligible for in-state tuition so long as the dependent relative is continuously enrolled in the degree or other program.

**S 137. MILITARY DEATH/IN-STATE TUITION/DEPENDENT.** Filed 2/11/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 3rd edition. Amends GS 116-143.3(c) to clarify that a dependent relative of a member of the armed services who dies during active military duty (was, is killed in combat or noncombat deployment or dies during active military duty) is eligible for a period as specified for the in-state tuition rate and applicable mandatory fees. Makes clarifying and conforming changes to the title.
