S 207. DUPLIN CHAIR VOTE ONLY IF TIE. Filed 2/17/09. *TO PROVIDE THAT IN THE CASE OF DUPLIN COUNTY, IF THE BOARD CONSISTS OF AN EVEN NUMBER OF MEMBERS, THE CHAIR OF A BOARD OF EDUCATION OR COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MAY VOTE ONLY IN THE CASE OF A TIE.*

Amends GS 115C-41(a) to provide that for the Duplin County Board of Education, if the board of education consists of an even number of members, the chairman may vote only if there is a tie. Amends GS 153A-39 to provide that for the Duplin County Board of Commissioners, if the board of commissioners consists of an even number, the chairman may vote only if there is a tie, unless the chairman is an officer elected separately by the people.
