S 248. CONFORM COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD VACANCY STATUTE. Filed 2/19/09. *TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION BY DELETING FROM A 1981 LAW RELATING TO FILLING VACANCIES IN COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION ELECTED ON A PARTISAN BASIS COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION THAT IN FACT ARE NOT ELECTED ON A PARTISAN BASIS.*

Amends GS 115C-37.1 (vacancies in offices of county boards elected on partisan basis in certain counties) to remove the following counties from the statute: Alamance, Avery, Beaufort, Buncombe, Burke, Cabarrus, Caldwell, Carteret, Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Davidson, Davie, Guilford, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Madison, McDowell, Mecklenburg, Moore, Polk, Randolph, Rockingham, Rutherford, Stanly, Stokes, Transylvania, Wake, and Yancey. Leaves Washington, Alleghany, Brunswick, Forsyth, Graham, New Hanover, and Vance counties subject to the statute.
