S 26. INJURY TO PREGNANT WOMEN/ADDITIONAL OFFENSE. Filed 2/2/09. TO AMEND THE STATE LAW THAT MAKES INJURY TO A PREGNANT WOMAN A ONE CLASSIFICATION HIGHER OFFENSE TO A SEPARATE OFFENSE, AND TO INCLUDE AS AN AGGRAVATING FACTOR IN FELONY CASES THAT THE VICTIM WAS PREGNANT.

Amends GS 14-18.2 as title indicates. Provides that for the purpose of the statute, a felony causing injury to a pregnant woman includes felony offenses that result in the pregnant woman's death. Provides that if the underlying offense is a Class A or a Class B1 felony, the separate offense is a Class A felony and that a felony under this section shall not be used as the underlying felony for a felony murder charge. Amends GS 15A-1340.16(d) to add pregnancy as an aggravating factor for sentencing. Includes whereas clauses. Effective December 1, 2009 and applicable to offenses committed on or after that date.
