Amends GS 10B-5(b)(9) to expand the exemption from submitting a recommendation from one state publicly elected official for notary public applicants that are receiving the oath of office from a register of deeds in a county where more than 14,000 (was, 15,000) active notaries public are on record on January 1 of the year the application is filed.
