S 268. NO ELECTED OFF. RECOMM./CERTAIN CO./NOTARIES. Filed 2/23/09. *TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF AN ELECTED OFFICIAL RECOMMENDATION FOR NOTARY PUBLIC APPLICANTS IN COUNTIES WITH MORE THAN FOURTEEN THOUSAND NOTARIES PUBLIC.*

Amends GS 10B-5(b)(9) to expand the exemption from submitting a recommendation from one state publicly elected official for notary public applicants that are receiving the oath of office from a register of deeds in a county where more than 14,000 (was, 15,000) active notaries public are on record on January 1 of the year the application is filed.

Senate amendment changes 1st edition by lowering from 14,000 to 5,250 the number of active notaries that must be on record in a county to eliminate the requirement that a notary public application include a letter of recommendation from an elected official. Makes a conforming change to the bill's title.
