S 327. GATESVILLE TERM LIMITS. Filed 2/25/09. AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF GATESVILLE TO EXTEND THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS AND STAGGERING THOSE TERMS.

Amends Section 4 of the Gatesville town charter to establish that regular municipal elections are to be held every four years and conducted in accordance with the uniform municipal election state laws. Provides that the mayor and members of the board of commissioners are elected according to the nonpartisan plurality method of election. Establishes that the commissioners and mayor are to be elected to four-year terms by voters of the entire town.

In 2009, and quadrennially thereafter, the mayor is to be elected to a four-year term. In 2009, for the position of Commissioner, two individuals receiving the highest number of votes are to be elected to four year terms, and one individual receiving the next highest number of votes is to be elected to a two-year term. In 2011, and quadrennially thereafter, one individual is to be elected to a four-year term. In 2013, and quadrennially thereafter, two individuals are to be elected to four-year terms.
