Incorporates the Town of Swannanoa, with the boundaries to be described. Incorporation is subject to approval by the voters of the described area at an election on November 3, 2009. The town is to be governed by a five-member town council and a mayor. Identifies by name seven temporary officers to serve as town council members until the organizational meeting after the initial municipal election is held in May 2010. The members of the town council serve four-year terms and the mayor serves two-year terms. Provides for the appointment of a town manager, attorney and clerk, for tax collection, budget ordinances, and other ordinances.

S 553. INCORPORATE SWANNANOA. Filed 3/11/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Describes the Swannanoa town boundaries. Amends the individuals appointed to serve as town council members until the organizational meeting after the initial election in May 2010. Provides that the filing period for the first regular municipal election to be held on May 4, 2010, is the same as provided in GS 163-106 (Notices of candidacy; pledge; with whom filed; date for filing; withdrawal). Prohibits Swannanoa from annexing any area beyond the southern border of the town's corporate limits that runs along a ridge line and borders the Fairview Township. Makes conforming changes. Changes the title to *AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF SWANNANOA, SUBJECT TO A REFERENDUM*.
