S 655. INCREASE DRIVERS LICENSE RESTORATION FEE. Filed 3/18/09. *TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR THE RESTORATION OF DRIVERS LICENSES TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE FORENSIC TESTS FOR ALCOHOL BRANCH OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.*

Amends GS 20-16.5(j) as title indicates to increase the fee from \$100 to \$125 as costs for restoration of a driver's license. Directs that \$50 of the costs collected (previously 50%) be credited to the General Fund, \$50 (previously 25%) be used to fund the statewide chemical testing program administered by the Forensic Tests for Alcohol Branch of the Department of Health and Human Services, and the remaining \$25 (previously 25%) be remitted to the county for jail expenses. Effective December 1, 2009, and applies to restorations of licenses occurring on or after that date.

S 655. INCREASE DRIVERS LICENSE RESTORATION FEE. Filed 3/18/09. Senate committee substitute deletes all provisions of 1st edition and replaces them with the following changes to GS 20-7(1). Increases all drivers license restoration fees by \$25 to be used to fund the chemical alcohol testing program administered by the Department of Health and Human Services. Effective July 1, 2010.

S 655. INCREASE DRIVERS LICENSE RESTORATION FEE. Filed 3/18/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition.

Deletes increased restoration fee (was, \$75) imposed on persons with licenses revoked for a reason other than impaired driving. Makes a conforming change to the title. Modifies the fee allocation to provide that the \$50 restoration fee and the first \$50 of the \$100 restoration fee for licenses revoked due to impaired driving will be deposited in the Highway Fund (was, \$50 of each fee). Directs \$25 of the \$100 fee (was, \$25 of each fee collected) to be used to fund the statewide chemical alcohol testing program administered by the Forensic Tests for Alcohol Branch of the Chronic Disease and Injury Section of DHHS, and deposits the remainder of the \$100 fee in the General Fund (was, \$25 of the \$100 fee).
