S 694. AMEND DENTISTRY LAWS/OUT OF STATE DENTISTS. Filed 3/19/09. *AMENDING THE LAWS PERTAINING TO THE PRACTICE OF DENTISTRY AS PERFORMED BY PERSONS PRACTICING DENTISTRY OUT OF STATE UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.*

Amends GS 90-36(e) to allow dentists who were licensed in other states and have secured a North Carolina license based on that other license and past active practice and who have established a North Carolina practice to continue to practice out-of-state for up to twelve months when the out-of-state care is done in connection with a formal contract or employment arrangement to provide clinical dental care to an ethnic or racial minority group living in a region with low access to dental care.
