S 762. SALARY SUPPLEMENT/SOME AUTOMOTIVE TEACHERS. Filed 3/23/09. *TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE A SALARY SUPPLEMENT OF TWELVE PERCENT TO NATIONALLY CERTIFIED TEACHERS IN HIGH SCHOOL AUTOMOTIVE PROGRAMS.*

Requires a high school automotive program teacher certified as an instructor by the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation to receive a 12% annual salary supplement. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules for the provision of the salary supplement including a process by which a teacher may verify that the (1) teacher is still employed as a full time employee by a local school administrative unit, (2) required certification has been attained and has not lapsed, and (3) teacher meets all of the qualifications to work as a high school automotive teacher in the state. Appropriates \$904,474 for 2009-10 and \$904,474 for 2010-11 from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction to implement the act. Effective July 1, 2009.
