S 865. NO STATE REGULATION OF TOXIC TITLE V SOURCES. Filed 3/25/09. TO REMOVE HAZARDOUS TITLE V SOURCES OF AIR POLLUTION FROM STATE REGULATION, WHICH APPLIES HEALTH-BASED AIR QUALITY STANDARDS, TO THE END THAT THESE HAZARDOUS TITLE V SOURCES WILL BE SUBJECT TO REGULATION UNDER ONLY THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT, WHICH APPLIES MAXIMUM ACHIEVABLE CONTROL TECHNOLOGY STANDARDS.

Amends GS 143-215.107(a) to specify that the North Carolina Environmental Management Commission's comprehensive plan for the prevention, abatement and control of air pollution in the State does not apply to any air emission source subject to hazardous air pollutant emission standards under 40 C.F.R. Pts. 61 and 63. Effective July 1, 2009.
