**S 9. AMEND PEEPING TOM LAW.** Filed 1/28/09. *TO CLARIFY THAT A PRIVATE DETECTIVE OR PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR WHO ENGAGES IN AN ACTIVITY THAT IS UNLAWFUL UNDER G.S. 14-202 WHICH PROHIBITS SECRETLY PEEPING INTO A ROOM OCCUPIED BY ANOTHER PERSON IS IN VIOLATION OF THAT LAW AND IS NOT PROTECTED BY THE CLAIM THAT THE DETECTIVE OR INVESTIGATOR WAS ENGAGED IN THE LEGAL DISCHARGE OF HIS OR HER OFFICIAL PROFESSIONAL DUTIES.*

Amends GS 14-202 to clarify that the exceptions to the peeping tom law for persons licensed under GS Chapter 74C that are found in GS 14-202(n) do not apply to private detectives or private investigators as defined in GS 74C-3(a)(8).
