A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO REDUCE STATE REGULATION OF EMISSIONS OF AIR TOXICS WHEN THESE EMISSIONS ARE REGULATED UNDER THE FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. G.S. 143-215.107(a) reads as rewritten:  "(a) Duty to Adopt Plans, Standards, etc. – The Commission is hereby directed and empowered, as rapidly as possible within the limits of funds and facilities available to it, and subject to the procedural requirements of this Article and Article 21:		
(5)	To develop and adopt emission control standards as in the Commission may be necessary to prohibit, abate, or concommensurate with established air quality standards.
