SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law and except as provided	
in Section 2 of this act, the Environmental Management Commission shall not adopt any	
permanent rule for the period beginning the day this act becomes law and ending July 1, 2011.	
SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the moratorium on the adoption of permanent rules	
established by Section 1 of this act, the Environmental Management Commission may adopt a	
•	during the moratorium period if the adoption of the rule is required by one or
more of the follo	
(1)	A serious and unforeseen threat to public health, safety, welfare, the
(4)	environment, or natural resources.
(2)	An act of the General Assembly or the United States Congress specifically
	directing the Commission to adopt a rule.
(3)	A change in federal or State budgetary policy.
(4)	A federal regulation.
(5)	A court order

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
