5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 8 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes is amended by		
7	adding the following new Part to read:		
8	"Part 13. Shopping Cart Sanitation.		
9	"§ 130A-288. Sanitation practices in certain retail mercantile establishments.		
10	(a) The purpose of this section is to protect consumers from shopping cart handles that		
11	may be contaminated with bodily fluids, including blood, saliva, mucus, and urine, and fecal		
12	matter, by encouraging that the means to disinfect or sanitize nonporous surfaces on shopping		
13	carts be provided to the public.		
14	(b) As used in this section, the following definitions mean:		
15	(1) <u>Retail mercantile establishment. – A place of business where m</u>	erchandise is	
16	displayed, held, or stored and sold or offered for sale to the publ	<u>ic.</u>	
17	(2) Shopping cart. – A push cart of the type that is commonly p	rovided by a	
18	retail mercantile establishment for public use in the trans	sportation of	
19	merchandise within the premises of the retail mercantile estab	lishment and	
20	from the retail mercantile establishment to a place outside the	premises of	
21	the retail mercantile establishment.		
22	(c) A retail merchandise establishment that provides shopping carts may m	<u>ake available</u>	
23	to the public free sanitation wipes at the entrance to its premises for use by the public	<u>lic.</u>	
24	(d) The Department or any local board of health shall encourage reta		
25	establishments to make available to the public free sanitation wipes at the en	trance to its	
26	premises and shall provide information on the benefits to the general public of providing the		
27	sanitation wipes.		
28	(e) Nothing in this section shall be construed to establish a private rig	<u>ght of action</u>	
29	against a person for failure or refusal to comply with this section."		
30	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
