The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall study and evaluate the tuition surcharge required by subsection (b) of Section 89 of Chapter 321 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by Section 17.10 of Chapter 769 of the 1993 Session Laws that mandates a twenty-five percent (25%) tuition surcharge on students who take more than 140 degree credit hours to complete a baccalaureate degree in a four-year program or more than one hundred ten percent (110%) of the credit hours necessary to complete a baccalaureate degree in any program officially designated by the Board of Governors as a five-year program. In conducting the study, the Board of Governors shall consider the following:
