- 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO STUDY 3 THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COYOTE NUISANCE REMOVAL PROGRAM IN THIS 4 STATE. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the development of 7 a coyote nuisance removal program aimed at diminishing the threat presented by the existence 8 of a coyote population in this State. The Commission shall consider all appropriate and feasible 9 options available for effectively reducing the coyote population in this State as quickly as 10 possible. SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to 11
- 12 the 2009 General Assembly, Regular Session 2010, and shall make its final report to the 2011 13 General Assembly.
- 14 **SECTION 3.** The Legislative Services Officer shall allocate funds appropriated to 15 the General Assembly for the expenditures of the Legislative Research Commission in 16 conducting this study. 17
 - SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
