SECTION 6. Article 3B of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

'§ 105-129.20. Allocation of federal §179D deduction.

To claim a deduction allowed under §179D of the Code, a taxpayer primarily responsible for designing energy efficient commercial building property that is installed in property owned by a governmental entity must obtain from the owner of the property written allocation of the deduction as provided under the Code. The governmental entity that enters into a design contract is the person designated as the person responsible for making the allocation allowed under §179 of the Code.'
