1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 5, by rewriting the line to read:
2 "EXPENSES AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE
3 VARIOUS SPECIAL PLATES ON A BACKGROUND OTHER THAN 'FIRST IN FLIGHT'.;

5 And on page 1, line 15, by rewriting the line to read:

6 "SECTION 2. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

7 (b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned to
8 the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be
9 abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued
10 for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more,
11 must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in
12 G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The
13 plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word
14 "weighted".

15 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division
16 for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less
17 shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight"
18 printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate
19 shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying
20 slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a
21 "First in Flight" plate. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be
22 approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.

**SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

(10d) ARTS NC. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "The Creative State" with a logo designed by ARTS North Carolina, Inc.

(47b) Friends of Camp Daniel Boone. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Friends of Camp Daniel Boone" and a logo provided by the Daniel Boone Council of the Boy Scouts of America.

(77b) Mountains-to-Sea Trail. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Mountains-to-Sea Trail" with a background designed by the Friends of the Mountains-to-Sea Trail, Inc.

(82a) Native Brook Trout. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the phrase "Native Brook Trout" and a picture of a Brook Trout native to North Carolina in the background.

**SECTION 4.** G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:

(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one registration plate to a recipient of a Legion of Valor award, a 100% disabled veteran, and an

**SECTION 5.** G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

'(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Natural Heritage Trust Fund (NHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, and the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

**SECTION 6.** G.S. 20-81.12 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

17     **(b73) Native Brook Trout.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the  
 18 Native Brook Trout plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer  
 19 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
 20 sale of Native Brook Trout plates to the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission to be  
 21 used to fund public access to, and habitat protection of, Brook Trout waters.

22     **(b74) Friends of Camp Daniel Boone.** – The Division must receive 300 or more  
 23 applications for the Friends of Camp Daniel Boone plate before the plate may be developed.  
 24 The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate  
 25 Account derived from the sale of Friends of Camp Daniel Boone plates to the Daniel Boone  
 26 Council of the Boy Scouts of America to be used to support Camp Daniel Boone's programs  
 27 and to pay administrative and operating expenses.

28     **(b75) Mountains-to-Sea Trail.** -- The Division must receive 300 or more applications for  
 29 the Mountains-to-Sea Trail plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer  
 30 quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the  
 31 sale of Mountains-to-Sea Trail plates to the Friends of the Mountains-to-Sea Trail, Inc., to be  
 32 used to fund trail projects and related administrative and operating expenses.

33     **(b76) ARTS NC.** – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for the ARTS NC  
 34 plate before the plate may be developed. The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the  
 35 Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of ARTS NC plates to  
 36 ARTS North Carolina, Inc., to provide funding to promote the arts in North Carolina.'


