1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, line 12, by rewriting that line to read:

3 "SECTION 3. The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall determine the  
4 availability of spaces for students in the Motorcycle Safety Foundation courses, the North  
5 Carolina Motorcycle Safety Education Program courses, and any other motorcycle education  
6 courses the Commissioner has approved in the State, in order to determine if there is adequate  
7 space in the available courses to meet the expected demand, and if the projected average wait  
8 time for an applicant to obtain a space in a course required by this act will exceed four weeks.  
9 The Commissioner shall report the results of the study to the Joint Legislative Commission on  
10 Governmental Operations on or before March 1, 2010.

11 SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective July 1, 2010. The  
12 remainder of this act becomes effective when it becomes law."
