1 moves to amend the bill on page 101, line 45,
2 by inserting on the line the following:
3 **"MEDICAID WAIVER TO PROVIDE HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED**
4 **MEDICAID SERVICES FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS**
5 **SECTION 10.74A.** The Department of Health and Human Services, Division of
6 Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, shall apply to the
7 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for a 1915(c) waiver to permit individuals who
8 sustain traumatic brain injury after age 22 to access home and community-based Medicaid
9 services. If approved, the Department shall not implement the waiver except as authorized by
10 an act of the General Assembly appropriating funds for this purpose. The Department shall
11 report on the status of the waiver to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Mental
12 Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the Senate Appropriations
13 Committee on Health and Human Services, the House of Representatives Appropriations
14 Subcommittee on Health and Human Services, and the Fiscal Research Division not later than
15 March 1, 2010."
