Senator Brown

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 34, by increasing the amount by five million dollars  
2 (\$5,000,000) in fiscal year 2009-2010 and by increasing the amount by five million dollars  
3 (\$5,000,000) in fiscal year 2010-2011; and

5 further moves to amend the bill on page 6, line 18, by decreasing the amount by five million  
6 dollars (\$5,000,000) in fiscal year 2009-2010 and by decreasing the amount by five million  
7 dollars (\$5,000,000) in fiscal year 2010-2011; and

9 further moves to amend the bill on page 38, line 29, by adding a new section after the line to  
10 read:

12 **"CAREER & TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOLS/PILOT PROJECT.**  
13 **SECTION 7.30.** The General Assembly finds that (i) students in schools with  
14 high-graduation rates are more likely to take at least four career/technical credits, and (ii) over  
15 fifty percent (50%) of North Carolina students indicate that career and technical education  
16 significantly contributed to their continued pursuit of a high school diploma; therefore, of the  
17 funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction by this act, five million dollars  
18 (\$5,000,000) shall be used by the Department to establish five pilot career and technical high  
19 school programs in various regions of the State. The purpose of these pilot high school  
20 programs shall be to lower the dropout rate by consolidating multiple career and technical  
21 education, world language, and advanced placement course offerings at a central location  
22 resulting in an efficient educational delivery system. These high school programs shall (i)  
23 provide globally competitive skill training to students aligned with the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce  
24 Goals and (ii) meet local and regional labor market needs. The Department of Public  
25 Instruction shall not use funds allocated for pilot programs established pursuant to this section  
26 for any other purpose."


