"CAREER & TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOLS/PILOT PROJECT.

SECTION 7.30. The General Assembly finds that (i) students in schools with high-graduation rates are more likely to take at least four career/technical credits, and (ii) over fifty percent (50%) of North Carolina students indicate that career and technical education significantly contributed to their continued pursuit of a high school diploma; therefore, of the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction by this act, five million dollars (\$5,000,000) shall be used by the Department to establish five pilot career and technical high school programs in various regions of the State. The purpose of these pilot high school programs shall be to lower the dropout rate by consolidating multiple career and technical education, world language, and advanced placement course offerings at a central location resulting in an efficient educational delivery system. These high school programs shall (i) provide globally competitive skill training to students aligned with the 21st Century Workforce Goals and (ii) meet local and regional labor market needs. The Department of Public Instruction shall not use funds allocated for pilot programs established b pursuant to this section for any other purpose."
