 4 Educational Services for the Deaf and Blind. The Task Force shall be composed of 9 voting
 5 members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
 6 three of whom shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and three of
 7 whom shall be appointed by the Governor. For the purposes of providing expertise and advice
 8 to the Task Force, the following members shall be appointed by the Governor to serve as ex-
 9 officio, nonvoting members:
 10 (1) Two educators certified to teach deaf children;
 11 (2) One educator certified to teach blind children; and
 12 (3) One graduate from each of the three residential schools.
 13 The Governor shall appoint the chair of the Task Force. The Task Force shall begin meeting
 14 not earlier than October 1, 2009 and shall meet not more than 4 times during the period October
 15 1, 2009 through April 30, ~~2009~~.
