1 moves to amend the bill on page 156, lines 18 through 24, by deleting those lines and  
2 substituting the following to read:

3 "SECTION 13.11.(a) Notwithstanding G.S. 105-164.44B, the Secretary of  
4 Revenue shall transfer no funds from the State sales and use tax net collections received by the  
5 Department of Revenue under Article 5 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes to the State  
6 Treasurer for the Wildlife Resources Fund during the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the 2010-2011  
7 fiscal year.

8 SECTION 13.11.(b) G.S. 105-164.44B reads as rewritten:

9 "§ 105-164.44B. Transfer to Wildlife Resources Fund of taxes on hunting and fishing  
10 supplies and equipment.

11 (a) Each fiscal year, the Secretary of Revenue shall ~~shall~~ subject to subsection (b) of  
12 this section, transfer at the end of each quarter from the State sales and use tax net collections  
13 received by the Department of Revenue under Article 5 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes  
14 to the State Treasurer for the Wildlife Resources Fund, one fourth of the amount transferred the  
15 preceding fiscal year plus or minus the percentage of that amount by which the total collection  
16 of State sales and use taxes increased or decreased during the preceding fiscal year.

17 (b) Each odd-numbered year, the House and Senate Appropriations Subcommittees on  
18 Natural and Economic Resources shall review the amount of the State sales and use tax net  
19 collections to be transferred during the upcoming biennium according to the formula set forth  
20 in subsection (a) of this section and may recommend lowering as necessary the amount of this  
21 transfer during the upcoming biennium. If lowered for any fiscal year under this subsection, the  
22 amount of the transfer of the State sales and use tax net collections shall be included in the  
23 current operations appropriation act for that biennium."
